

# Junior High Awards

There are various occasions throughout the school year when student achievement is recognized.

## **Honour Board**

Having their names placed on the Honour Board at each reporting period recognizes students attaining a minimum average of 80% in Core subjects, with no mark below 65%, based on report card marks. Core subjects are: Science, Social Studies, Language Arts, and Mathematics.

## **Awards Evening**

An awards evening is held in June. Students are recognized for academic excellence, athletic excellence, participation in school activities and overall service and contribution to the school.

# Award Criteria for Selection

## **Year End Honours:**

An average of 80% or more in Core subjects, with no mark below 65%, based on third term marks.

## **Highest Academic Achievement:**

Is given to the student in each of Grades 7, 8 and 9 with the highest average in Core subjects.

## **LSL School Council Award for Most Improved Academically:**

Is awarded to the student who has shown the greatest increase in academic average of Core subjects from the first to the third term, and who has shown consistent effort.

## **LSL School Council Award for Junior High Honours:**

Are given to Grade 9 students who have maintained an honours standing throughout Junior high.

## **Complementary Course Achievement Awards:**

Are presented to one student per grade, per course displaying outstanding performance, a positive attitude and consistent effort in option courses.

## **Gauss Mathematics Awards:**

Top Gauss Math competitors in each of Grades 7 and 8. (Spring of each year)

## **Edmonton Junior High Math Contest Award:**

Top Grade 9 competitors (Spring of each year)

## **Most Valuable Player Awards:**

Are awarded to the individuals judged to be the most valuable to his or her respective teams

**Outstanding Male / Female Athletes in Inter-school Athletics:**

Are presented to students who have shown athletic involvement, achievement, positive leadership and good sportsmanship.

**Student Leadership Award:**

Is given to an individual who has demonstrated positive leadership, effort and commitment.

**Outstanding Band Award:**

Is presented to an individual who is a committed student and who makes an overall contribution to the band.

**Service Award:**

Is presented to an individual who has consistently provided assistance to and in support of students who are new to the school.

**Most Improved Student:**

Is given to a student who has shown improvement in behavior, attitude, cooperation, effort and achievement.

**Knights of Columbus Caritas Award:**

Awarded to a Grade 9 student who has attended LSL for a minimum of two years, has a 70% average or better in Core subjects, sets a Christian example and participates in both curricular and extra-curricular activities.

**Ron Woytiuk Humanitarian Award:**

Honours the individual who exhibits deep concern for the welfare of others, and who is positive and possesses leadership skills.

**LSL School Council Award:**

Is presented to one student in each of Grades 7, 8 and 9 who aspire to be healthy physically, emotionally and spiritually.

**Yvonne Lemay Outstanding Student Award:**

Grades 7, 8, 9 – is bestowed upon one student per grade who demonstrates high academic achievement, leadership skills, good school spirit, and involvement in school and community activities.

**The Sharon Pisesky Unsung Hero Award:**

This award will be presented to a Grade 9 student who maintained a 65% average, exemplifies Catholic core values in his/her interaction with fellow students and staff, and made a positive contribution to the culture of the school through student activities in the fine arts, student government and other activities without receiving adequate recognition.
